Adah Rose Bitterbaum is the owner and Director of the Adah Rose Gallery in Kensington Maryland. The gallery was founded in September of 2011 as a place to exhibit contemporary art in a variety of medium.

The gallery is a dynamic place and hosts artists talks, panels on issues in the art world, maintains an active intern program and shows art in a variety of spaces including pop ups. The gallery was regularly reviewed in the Washington Post until the galleries column ended in August, 2024. The gallery also works with emerging artists and showcases the work of recent MFA graduates.
